



POST GRADUATE PARKING 2009 –CUMBERLAND CAMPUS

Parking for post graduate students is allocated by ballot each year. Approximately 80 places are allocated for access to the car park at Gate 2 which provides access 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Priority is given in the ballot to full time post graduate students - this will be verified through Student Central

To apply for the ballot you must complete the Postgraduate Application for Parking 2009 form and return to Campus Infrastructure services by 4.00 pm Friday 13 February, 2009. Results of the ballot will be posted on the Official Notice Board outside A Block, Jeffery Miller Administration Building by noon Thursday, 19 February, 2009.

For students unsuccessful in the ballot we are able to offer after hours and weekend access via Gate 2 at the following times: 3.30 pm – 11.00 pm Monday to Friday and 6.00 am - 11.00 pm weekends.

FAQs

What are the different parking categories?

- Gate 2 Access through Gate 2, 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. Determined by ballot. *Swipe card only.*
- After 3.30 pm and Weekends Gate 2 Access through Gate 2 from 3.30pm to 11.00 pm Monday to Friday and weekend access via Gate 2 from 6.00 am to 11.00 pm Saturday and Sunday. *Swipe card only*

How much does it cost? \$98.90 (Inc GST)

Where and when do I pay? If you are successful in the ballot you will need to contact the Campus Infrastructure Services and pay at the Cashier between the hours of 9.00 am and 4.30 pm by 6 March, 2009.

What if I already have parking for 2008? You must reapply for parking for 2009. However, your current access will be active until 4.00 pm 28 February, 2009.

What other parking is available? Gate 3 Weeroona Rd - \$3.00 Pay and Display machines will operate. Pay and display machines dispense a printed ticket which must be clearly displayed on the vehicle dashboard, in accordance with the instructions printed upon it. Any vehicle not displaying a current University parking permit, an approved temporary visitor's pass, or a valid Pay and Display ticket is liable to be infringed. The registered owner of the vehicle is responsible for any penalty imposed.
